Please note that meals will be covered while travelling at the agreed upon daily rate as outlined in the expense form. At the venue coaches are expected to eat with the athletes where possible. COACH RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Regular on hill coaching duties
- Coaches will not share rooms with athlete(s) unless they have an athlete that is a son or daughter
- Coaches of opposite gender may share a room at their discretion
- Coaches will not be "double bunked"
- Coaches primary role is to train and coach the athletes
- While a coach will not be directly responsible for athletes off of the ski hill, they are expected to assist the chaperones with supervision of the athletes. Coaches will be responsible for discipline of the athletes.
- Coaches are expected to have a meeting with the athletes at the end of the day
- Coaches are expected to explain the seeding criteria that will be used at the event, including ultimate discretion to the coach.
- Coaches are to act as an advocate for the athletes (tuning, nutrition, etc)
